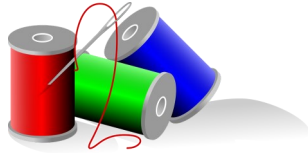


The 2024-2025 Season for Co-Ed Couples Golf will begin on Sunday, November 3, 2024.
